

About Youngsan University

Youngsan University is an expanding global university opened in March 1997. Youngsan University has two campuses. The original campus was founded in Yangsan, a suburb of Busan, which is a calm but exciting southeastern city in the Republic of Korea. In 2003, Youngsan University purchased Sungsim College of Foreign Languages which is located in just minutes from Haeundae Beach. Busan is a bustling seaport city and the second largest city in South Korea. The University also has three auxiliary learning centers in Seoul, Busan and Ulsan, and in all of these places of learning we do provide thousands of graduates equipped with both academic knowledge, practical skills, and job placement.

Youngsan University consists of four departments of graduate schools (i.e. Graduate School of Law, Business Administration, Real Estate, and Tourism) and eight colleges in areas such as Hotel & Tourism Management, Foreign Languages & International Business, Culture Technology, Law & Economics, IT • Architecture & Landscape, Physical Education, and University College of Undeclared Majors.

As a newcomer spearheading practical professional education in Korea, Youngsan University has strived to provide high quality education and establish its position as one of the leading providers of professional education in Korean society. The international academic exchange project we are pursuing is a way to achieve our educational globalization in the ongoing international context. It maintains some cooperative programs with other international educational institutions to meet the increasing social demand for globalization.

Youngsan University is producing competitive intellectuals by providing outstanding programs, an excellent faculty and advanced educational facilities. It is fast becoming one of the most prestigious universities by producing the people needed by society and by contributing to the development of both the nation and the world.

■ Brief History

- June 20, 1973 Sungsim Education Foundation is established.
- Dec. 11, 1996 The charter for Youngsan University of International Affairs is authorized. Eight departments with 940 students are established.
- Mar. 10, 1997 Youngsan University of International Affairs opens and Dr. Chunkoo Jeong takes office as the first president of the university.
- May 1, 1998 Youngsan University of International Affairs is renamed Youngsan University.
- Aug. 5, 1999 The Institute of Social Education is approved by the Ministry of Education.
- Nov. 2, 1999 The establishment of the graduate schools is approved.
The departments are Hotel, Tourism and Management, and Legal Affairs.
- Jan. 25, 2000 Dr. Kwan Yun, the Former Chief Justice, takes office as the honorary president of Youngsan University. Dr. Sam-sung Yang, the chief lawyer of Hwabaek Lawtakes office as the vice president of Legal Affairs.
- July 18, 2000 The establishment of the Graduate School of Computer and Information Communication is approved.
- Feb. 15, 2001 Dr. Guwuck Bu takes office as the second president of Youngsan University.
- Mar. 01, 2003 Youngsan University merges with Sungsim College of Foreign Languages.
- Mar. 01, 2004 Five Graduate Schools (including the School of TEFL, and Real Estate), 51 majors in 20 undergraduate schools are offered.
- Mar. 01, 2005 Five Graduate Schools, nine colleges of undergraduate schools equipped with 54 concentrations are offered.
- Mar. 01, 2006 Five Graduate Schools, seven colleges of undergraduate schools equipped with 41 concentrations are offered.
- Mar. 01, 2007 Six majors in Four Graduate Schools, eight colleges of undergraduate schools equipped with 36 concentrations will be offered.
- Mar. 01, 2008 Seven majors in Five Graduate Schools, Nine colleges of undergraduate schools equipped with 40 concentrations will be offered.

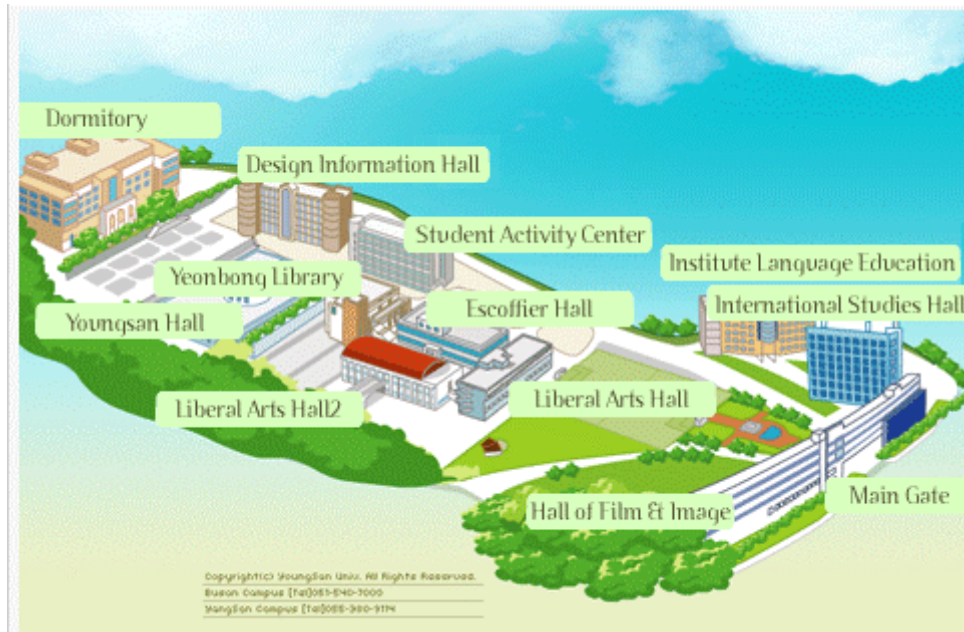

Yongsan University provides a wide variety of welfare facilities and services so that faculty and students can concentrate on their studies in a comfortable environment.

■ **Housing (Dormitory)**

The University has two dormitories at the Yangsan campus and one dormitory at the Busan campus. It is available to undergraduate students and graduate students with separate floors for men and women. These dormitories can accommodate up to 936 students. Four students share one room.

Every room is equipped with LAN connections for Internet use. The dormitory has lounge areas, study areas, exercise areas and laundry facilities (washing machines and dryers). It has central heating. Dorm rooms are western-style, with 2 pairs of bunk beds. In addition to a bed, each person is provided a wardrobe, a desk, and a small bookcase.

Students are responsible for purchasing their own meals. There is no meal plan, but there are many alternatives. Students may buy their meals in one of the college cafeterias, or in the university area's restaurants. Many meals cost as little as the equivalent of US\$3~4.

■ **Scholarships and Financial Aid**

All international students are eligible to receive partial tuition and full entrance fee scholarships during his/her study at Yongsan University. He/she also has a chance to receive a partial tuition scholarship based on his/her academic performance.

■ **Activities**

There are 43 student clubs at Yongsan University. Student clubs, so-called "Dong-A-Ri", are volunteer organizations for student activities. Participation in Dong -A-Ri is the best way to make friends, develop student responsibilities and find leadership qualities. This enables students to grow and learn new experiences on campus. Presently there are 43 Dong-A-Ri clubs surrounding the main Dong-A-Ri association in our university.

■ **Library**

The library opened on the 6th floor of the Sungsim Hall at the Yangsan Campus in March 1997. In September 2001, the present library building was completed to play its part in this fast-growing university and it has been serving as the resource-center of Yongsan University. It

is open to all members of the university community and provides 1,034 reading tables. Library hours are from 9:30 a.m. to 9:30 p.m. Monday to Friday and from 9:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Saturday. (Sundays and holidays closed, and during vacation the hours are 9:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday and 9:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Saturday.), but for general reading the hours are from 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. throughout the year.

■ Cafeteria

One student cafeteria on the Yangsan campus, seating over 400 students, is located on the second floor of Munhwa-kwan, and the one on the Busan campus at the student center. Each campus also has a dining room for staff and professors. We serve several types of food such as western, Asia, Korean recipe and so on. We usually serve dishes at an affordable price (₩1,500~₩2,500). The daily menu is posted on the wall in front of the cafeteria every morning.

■ Student Counseling Center

The Student Counseling center is located on the first floor of Sungsim Hall at the Yangsan Campus in order to help students with all types of problems that may occur during their stay at Youngsan University such as adapting to campus life, academic concerns, personal relationships, and discovering student talents. There are personal counseling programs as well as group counseling programs and workshops.

■ Computer Rooms

Students can apply for an email address at their departments. They can use the computers at the computer rooms at each campus. Also each department has computer labs open to the students. Please check the hours open to students.

■ Campus Clinic

If you are confident about your spoken Korean, a Campus Clinic is available. It is located on the first floor of the Sungsim-kwan at Yangsan campus. For common colds and minor complaints, seeing the pharmacist is usually sufficient, but for any persistent or serious problem, go see a doctor. There is a drugstore on practically every block in the city. Most prescription drugs are available in Korea.
